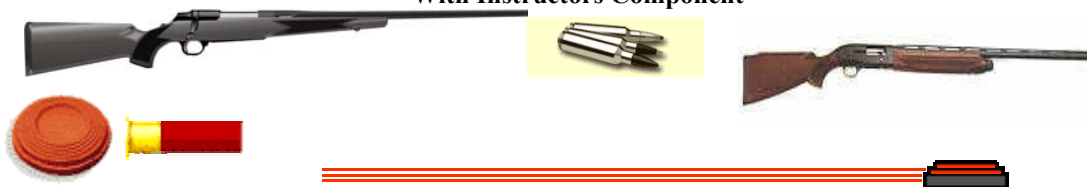


NRA Certified Rifle- Shotgun Instructors Class

With Instructors Component



Class is 31 Hours

Why: To Become a NRA Certified Rifle and Shotgun Instructor

Who: Anyone Over the Age of 21 for Certified Instructor, 17-20 for assistant instructor, without a Felony or domestic violence conviction or under indictment. Must either be an NRA Certified Instructor or take Instructor Component prior to course.

Cost: \$325 per participant. \$60 due at registration, refundable only if not approved for class, balance due first class. Class limited to 12

Evaluations: by arrangement with Instructor. Evaluations are \$10, to be held at Bake's Best Shot or by other arrangement. Guns are available to use, or you can bring your own (no reloads on ammo you bring). Evaluations must be arranged before start of class.

Policies: You must be a law abiding citizen to take our courses. You cannot have any Felony convictions nor any convictions of domestic violence. You also cannot be under indictment for any of the above. Under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian..

Class sizes are limited to 12. Minimum class size is 6. \$60 or class cost due at registration. Refundable only if not approved for class or if class is cancelled. Balance due first class.

Registrations are in order received (with Deposit). Registration deadline for classes: Third Monday before the class you are registering for unless prior arrangements are made with the instructor.

Included in all classes: Pens, pencils, paper, notebooks, class materials, range time. Guns are available to use for class, or bring your own.

NO AMMO IS PERMITTED IN CLASS!

Ammunition is not included. No reloads permitted on range. Ammo is available for purchase on the range (Except Shotgun).
